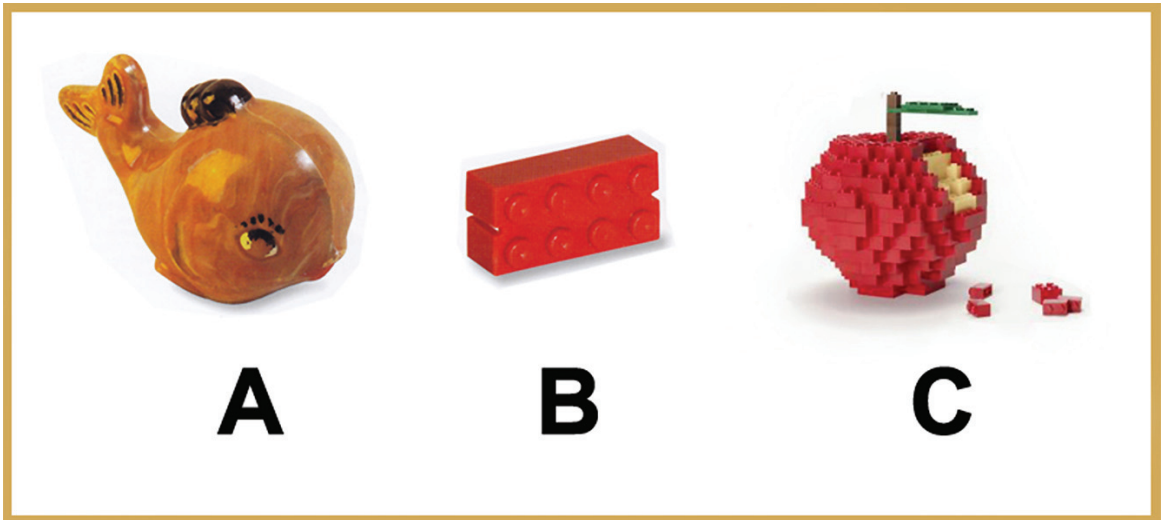

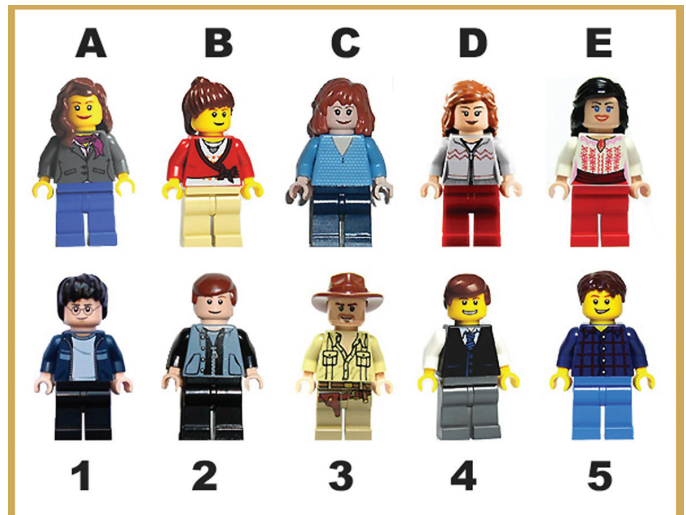

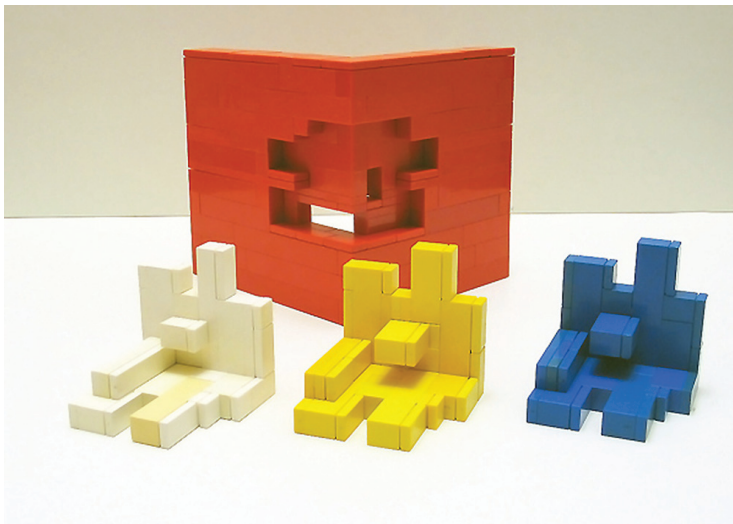

Which assembly can fill the hole in the wall?

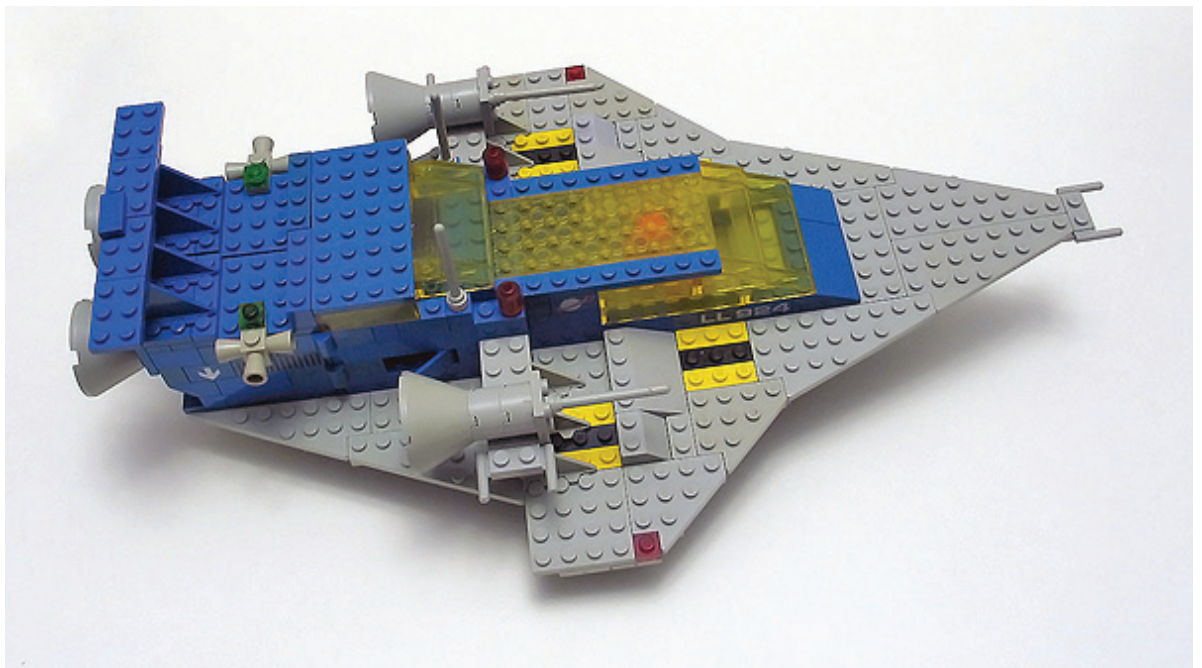




Find the brick! Which brick can make this kind of shadow?
