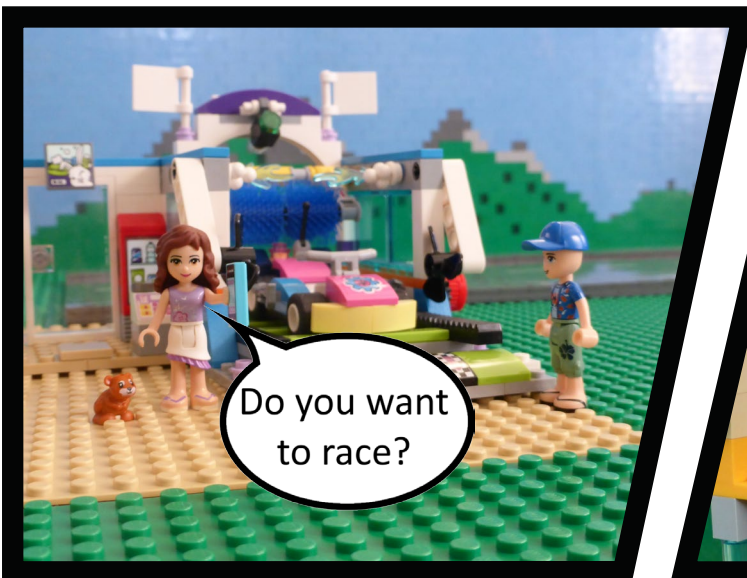
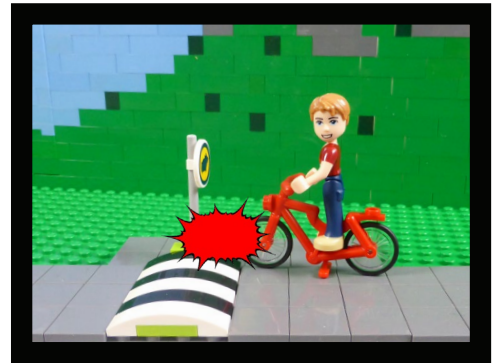
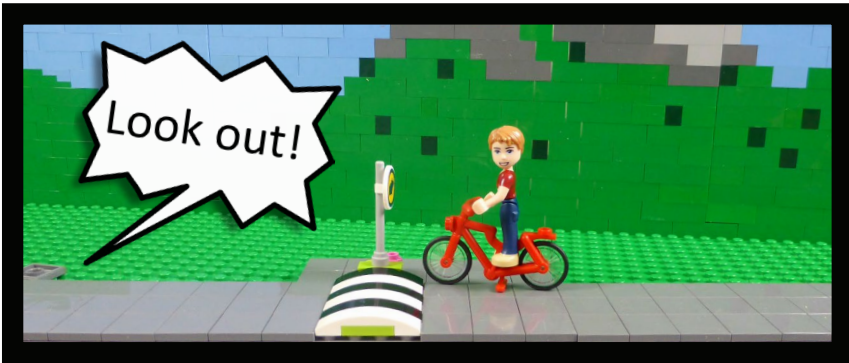
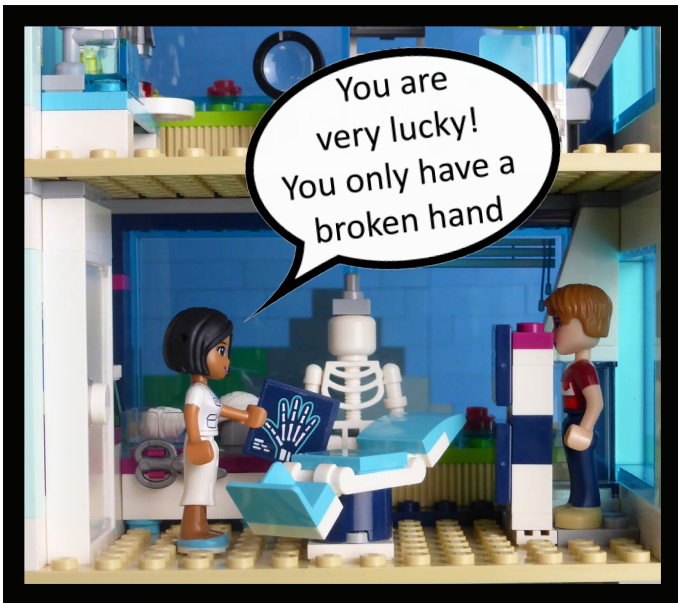


The Day of the Race
